Comprehensive Community Care

A support program for seniors providing case management and primary care to elderly clients - allowing them to remain at home with a higher quality of life. Care is provided by a 24-hour team through a medical clinic, day program, home support, transportation, access to designated continuing care beds and emergency response telephone system.



At Home

Our Community Care Assistants will help you with managing your personal care (such as bathing, getting dressed, taking medications). A Registered Nurse is just a phone call away – day or night through our 24-hour telephone service. We may also phone you to remind you about your medications.



Social Opportunities

Social opportunities are an important part of the C3 program. The Day Centre provides an ideal environment to make friends and take part in meaningful activities.



If you need ongoing medical care, home services and day support to remain independent at home, the C3 program could be for you. Our objective is to help you manage your physical, medical and social wellbeing. We will assist you with medications, laboratory tests, specialist appointments and therapy.
