THERAPY

Mental Health Triage and Trauma Counselor

Operational Stress Injury (OSI) Clinic – an outpatient clinic funded by Veterans Affairs Canada that supports former and current Canadian Forces members, and members of the RCMP suffering from an Operational Stress Injury who require specialized assessment and treatment.

This Regular Full Time position located at our Market Mall location is part of an interdisciplinary team, responsible for providing mental health assessment, triage, individual, group and family counseling, case coordination and crisis intervention to clients of the Operational Stress Injury Clinic. Clients are referred by Veterans Affairs Canada (VAC), Department of National Defence (DND) and Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP). Responsible for other related duties as required.

Qualifications:

- Post-secondary degree in a related health science discipline required. Master's degree preferred
- Registration with appropriate professional body required.
- Minimum 3-5 years' experience in clinical roles with a mental health population.
- Experience in mental health assessment/triage and treatment required.
- Experience with individual, group and family counseling preferred.
- Previous experience in PE, EMDR, CBT and ACT an asset.
- Experience with a military population would also be an asset.
