01



**Find the emergency site cell phone and look through the Evacuation Kit at Main Reception**  
What are 2 items you will need from the kit if there is a large flood on your unit? If a client is missing, the team searching outside will take a cell phone.

02



**Read the Statement of Commitment to Health and Safety -in hall by recptn.**  
Safety is everyone's responsibility. If you see something unsafe - give it your attention.

03



**Read the Frame of Reference and Philosophy of Care -other hall by recptn.**  
How will you demonstrate the Carewest value of caring in your daily work?

04



**Take your blood pressure in the Wellness Center**  
Everyone has a responsibility for their own personal wellness.

05



**Find the Resident, Client and Family Feedback Forms -photo intro to CSM**  
If a resident or family member has a concern or compliment and the manager is offsite, please encourage them to fill out a form.

06



**Find a visibility wall**  
Visibility walls are one of the ways the team communicates. Ask when & where your unit has scheduled Vis Wall Huddles and try to attend.

07



**Find the Education Board**  
The Education Board is on 2nd floor near the Administration Offices. If you haven't met educator Stephanie yet, please introduce yourself today.

08



**Find the Job Board**

Career Opportunities are also posted on Careweb.

09



**Find the resident smoking room**

Oxygen tanks are not allowed in the smoking room. There is a fire blanket in the room. If a resident's clothing catches on fire, wrap the blanket around them.

**Find pull stations**

Review REACT.  
What does the 'A' in REACT stand for?

**Each neighborhood has fire separation doors**

Evacuate residents past the doors in Code Red.

12



**Flanders Gibraltar is the Most Responsible Unit (MRU)**

Any available staff reads the panel, pages and phones 9-911 in a Code Red. If the fire is in Flanders Gibraltar, then Highlander Lancaster will do this. Practice making a test page by dialing 7144.

13



**Find fire extinguishers**

Only fight fires that are shorter than your waist and no wider than your body. Review **PASS** - Pull the Pin - twist off tie first Aim at the base of the fire Squeeze the trigger Sweep back and forth

14



**Each floor has a Family Dining Room**

Report, family meetings, and education is sometimes held here.

15



**Kitchenettes and Dining Rooms**

If you see someone choking, shout for help. Start abdominal / chest thrusts on a conscious person to relieve the object.

16



**Lower Main / Basement**

Go down and look around! Find the kitchen, maintenance (PPS), lockers and housekeeping areas.
