Carewest conducted its first 2025 Resident Survey from end of Jan to mid March 2025


7 sites (Signal Pointe did not get captured due to only 3 people being identified as possibly being able to do this)

171 Residents surveyed through staff and Volunteers


147 Caregivers responded to the survey

Approach


- Sites sent emails out to clients re: survey
- A staff member started out at 4 sites.
- Sites pulled lists of those residents that were their own decision maker
- Surveyor then went to site and asked for consent and whether they would be interested.
- Mid way through Volunteer services took over for the last 4 sites.







Overall


- Kind and respectful staff
- Connections were the highest rated category

Activities

- >66% satisfied with activities
- Would like:
 - Weekends and evenings in high demand
 - Variety (broader offerings)

Meals

- Adequate amount of food and hydration
- Strong correlation between dining experience to food quality
- Would like:
 - · Choice and enhance the taste of food
 - Meals at correct temperature



Meals and Dining Action Plan

- Food Services will implement two distinct menus:
 - one for Long-Term Care (LTC) and one for Post-Acute Care.
 - This change is designed to enhance flexibility and better meet the needs of our clients.
- Key benefits of this approach include:
 - Improved accommodation of special requests
 - Greater flexibility in therapeutic diet liberalization for LTC clients.
 - More themed and special meals to enhance resident engagement and enjoyment.
 - Menus more closely aligned with the preferences and needs of LTC residents.

This supports our ongoing commitment to personalized; high-quality nutrition services tailored to the unique needs of each individual and care setting.

Activities Action Plan

 Based on this survey the following programming has been added or in progress:

- Resident and Volunteer-led Karaoke at Fanning
 - Currently Thursday afternoons but will transition to Friday evenings this fall
- Spring concert series Friday evenings at Fanning & Sarcee, resuming in the fall
- Additional non-denominational church services at Garrison Green and George Boyack
- Recruitment of 15 new 1:1 visitor volunteers to engage with our more socially isolated residents
- Targeted OT/PT volunteers to engage with LTC clients in rehab programs: successfully implemented at Garrison Green in July with future expansion to other sites
- A pilot for Sarcee for volunteer accompaniment on client appointments, with potential expansion to other LTC sites in the future
- Launch Night Owls Program Grant 2 yr funding for evening Rec Therapy at 3 sites

Fall 2025 LTC Survey

- Let residents know that we want their input, make it special!
 - Prior to survey, deliver invitations to residents who are eligible to participate in survey
 - Posters up on unit for awareness of staff and residents
- Centralize the volunteer*(rather than having the volunteer searching to find people they do not know)
 - Successful Sarcee trial
 - Will still go to residents who are unable to come to central location
